



FuelMaker and KeySpan Partner to Introduce Home Refueling Appliance for Compressed Natural Gas Vehicles During Long Island Auto Show

Toronto, Canada and Hicksville, NY, October 19, 2006 - FuelMaker Corporation is proud to partner with KeySpan Energy Delivery to introduce Phill, the world's first home refueling appliance for Natural Gas Vehicles. The appliance is on display at the Long Island Auto Show along with America Honda Motor Co., Inc.'s 2007 Civic GX compressed natural gas-powered vehicle which is now available to retail dealers.

Phill is conveniently installed indoors or outdoors, connecting to an existing natural gas and electrical supply. Easy to use, Phill will refuel a typical commuter vehicle overnight, shutting off when the tank is full. Refueling a typical compact car overnight allows for over 100 miles of travel.

"We are pleased to partner with KeySpan and introduce Phill on Long Island," said Mario Pirraglia, Vice President of Sales and Marketing at FuelMaker. "Partnerships with companies such as KeySpan will help bring Phill to homes across the country. Using a home refueling appliance allows people to save on energy costs as natural gas prices are lower and traditionally more stable than gasoline, and it provides for the convenience of refueling at home."

"Compressed natural gas vehicles are clean burning, low emission alternatives to traditional fuel cars," said Ronald J. Gulmi, Natural Gas Vehicle Program Manager for KeySpan Energy Delivery. "KeySpan has very successful partnerships with public and private entities on Long Island that use CNG vehicles. The relationship that we have developed with FuelMaker reflects the growing interest in CNG vehicles in this region and opens the door for further expansion and support of this technology into the residential market on Long Island."

Natural gas is a lower-cost, clean burning alternative to gasoline. Primarily a domestically-produced fuel, natural gas also enjoys 44 cents per gallon equivalent tax savings in New York State versus gasoline.

FuelMaker and KeySpan Energy Delivery are working together to promote home refueling on Long Island. FuelMaker launched Phill in California in February 2005. It is currently also available in Arizona, Colorado, Utah and select cities in other states.
