### **The City of Vacaville in California Announces \$2000 Incentive For the Purchase of “Phill”, the Home Refueling Appliance**

*Vacaville, CA February 2007* – The City of Vacaville, California has announced a \$2000 incentive for the purchase and installation of the “Phill” Home Refueling Appliance by FuelMaker.

Residents of the Northeastern portion of Solano County (Vacaville, Dixon, Elmira, and Rio Vista) who are part of the City’s Compressed Natural Gas vehicle (CNG) incentive program will receive \$2000 off of the purchase of Phill. Eligible residents must own a dedicated CNG vehicle or have a confirmed order of a vehicle on record. Residents qualify for one incentive per Phill installed at their place of residence, and this incentive is in addition to the up to \$7000 offered on the purchase of a new, dedicated CNG vehicle.

The city of Vacaville is the first city in the nation to offer such incentives to its residents, and thanks to it’s CNG Vehicle Program now has the most number of dedicated CNG vehicles per capita (residential side) in the nation.
